

How To Create A Free Web Host Account

Step 1: The registration process does not accept Hotmail or Yahoo addresses so get a [GMail](#) account.

Step 2: Register [here](#).

Step 3: Click your activation link in the mail.

Step 4: You will be brought to a page containing your hosting records, something like what you see below. Download a copy. For display reasons, I erase my username and password.

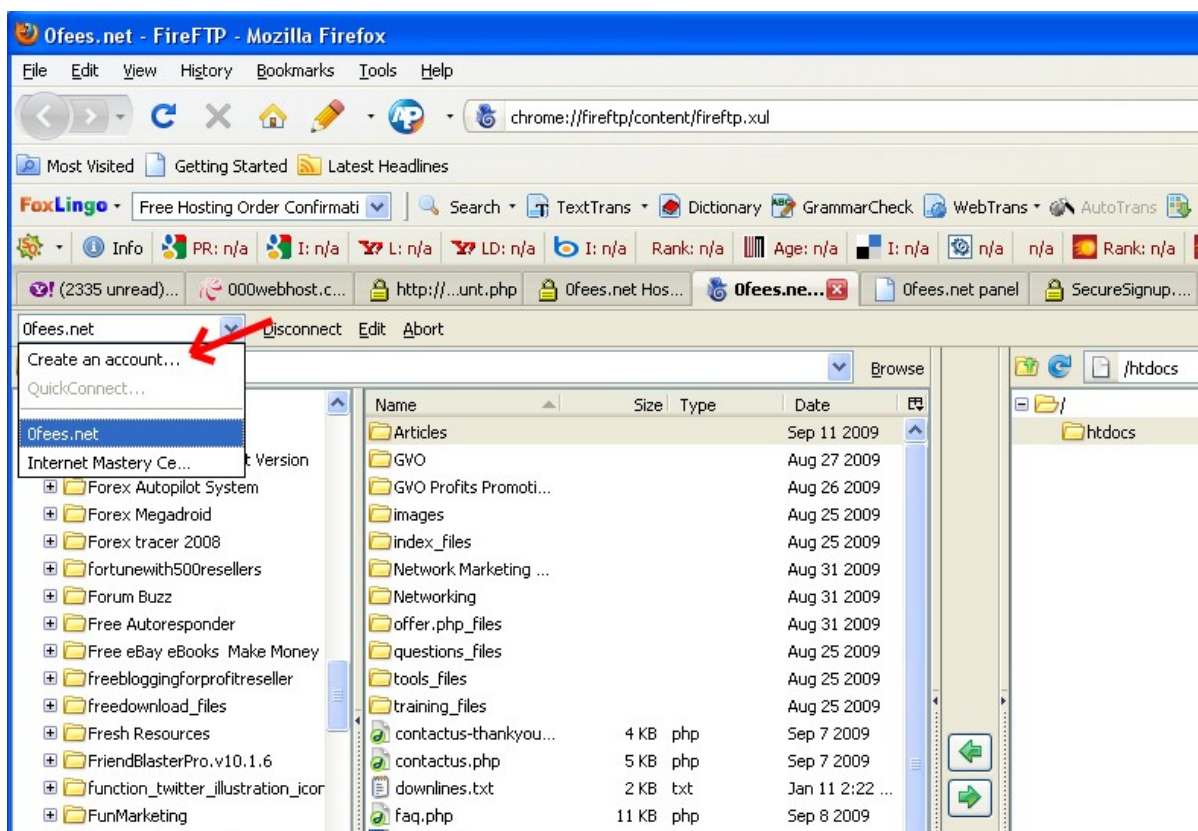

Step 5: There are 2 ways I use to upload files to my hosting account. You can open up Windows Explorer and type in <ftp://username.password@ftp.0fees.net> (using your username and password) in the Address bar.

The other way is to install a free FTP client addon for the Firefox browser. Download [FireFTP](#). You'll be asked to restart Firefox after installation. Go to Tools → FireFTP. Select the "Create an account" option (see below).



Fill in the following:

Account Name: Ofees.net (any name will do)

Host: ftp.Ofees.net

Login: your username

Password: your password

Click 'OK' and you're done.

Step 6: Click 'Connect' to connect to your hosting account. Whenever you want to upload your files, just click, hold and drag them to the 'htdocs' subdirectory. The same goes with using Windows Explorer as your FTP client.
